1. Explorational Research of Useful Microbes

Thermotolerant advantageous microbes, Biopolymer degradation, Functional materials, Bio-active compounds

2. Genome-based Research on Thermotolerant Microbes

Distribution of thermotolerant microbes, Genome modification, Deep sequencing

3. Research on Environmental Microbes Sustaining Tropical Ecosystem

Symbiosis, Plant- or animal (Insect)-microbe interaction, Microbial consortia in fermented foods & sewages, Metagenome analysis

4. Research on Microbes Useful for Food, Food Preservation, Health, and Ecosystem

Preservation

Food and beverage, Bio-packaging, Chemicals, Biopreservation, Probiotics, Bioremediation, Biocontrol

5. Development of Next-generation Fermentation Technology for New Wave Industry

High-temperature fermentation, Pilot scale fermentation, Renewable energy
